

Correction Checklist

We have completed a review of your **Permits Online Application tracking #** [REDACTED] and found that the application requires some corrections and/or additional information before we can continue the review process.

Please make the following changes and/or provide additional information to your application, then re-submit to TTB. If you want to provide comments about the corrections made, you may do so in the Correction Comments section near the end of the application.

Be sure to address all requested corrections and re-submit the application in one session. If you select "Save and Resume Later" some of your changes may not be saved.

The proposed DSP location in your application has been flagged for further review to determine whether the proposed locations is prohibited under 26 U.S.C. 5178(a)(1)(B) and 27 C.F.R. 19.52. A person who intends to establish a DSP may not locate it in any of the following places: (a) In any residence, shed, yard, or enclosure connected to a residence; (b) On any vessel or boat; (c) Where beer or wine is produced; (d) Where liquors are sold at retail; or (e) Where any other business is conducted except as provided in 27 C.F.R. 19.54. However, pursuant to court order, TTB may not apply this prohibition to members of the Hobby Distillers Association. Opinion and Order, Hobby Distillers Ass'n v. Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau. No. 4:23-vc-1221 (N.D.Tex uly 10, 2024), appeal pending No. 24-10760 (5th Cir.). In order for TTB to process your application in accordance with the court order, TTB must identify whether you are a member of the Hobby Distillers Association. Please confirm whether you are a member of the Hobby Distillers Association and, if so, provide proof of your membership within 15 days (2/13/2026) so we may process your application in a timely manner.

In Step 4: Upload required documents, Step 4b: Attach files: Upload an executed copy of your Lease Agreement that is signed by both parties and includes the business name and premises address. You may also submit a signed statement addressing the missing legal business name and premise address.

In Step 2, Operation Description, Step 2A, DSP Beverage Operation Info - Describe how bulk spirits will be stored: Please state how you will be storing your bulk spirits. For example: "bulk spirits will be stored in totes" or "stored in a steel tank".

You also have the option of withdrawing the application if you cannot provide all requested information/corrections within this target date. If you wish to withdraw state your intention in the Applicant response located at the end of your application.
